Funds are forwarded on to M&S offices in Toronto. Money is used to support the United Church's service and ministry in Canada and around the globe. If no direction is provided for donations marked "Other", that donation will be allocated to the Outreach to Burnaby's Homeless.

First United

Funds are forwarded to First United Church, for their mission in Vancouver's downtown eastside.

Building Contingency Fund

Funds are accumulated in order to cover future significant repairs to DLUC's building.

Edmonds Outreach Payable

Money raised for this fund goes to the Edmonds Youth Resource Centre, which provides support to disadvantaged youth in our community.

Student Ministry Fund

Donations to this fund may be drawn on by ministry inquirers and candidates who are also active members of DLUC in order to assist them with theology course funding.

Dixon House

Funds are forwarded to the Marguerite Dixon Transition Society, which runs a shelter for battered women in Burnaby.

Outreach to Burnaby's Homeless

Funds collected help pay for groceries needed to provide sandwiches and other lunch foods once per month to Burnaby's homeless population. Lunches are delivered to Southside Community Church where the Progressive Housing Society operates their Homeless Outreach Program.

Memorial Fund

This fund accepts donations made to honour the memory of deceased members of DLUC. Funds accumulate until spending is authorized by the Board. In general, funds are used to purchase items of a long-term nature which benefit many members of DLUC, or to support worthwhile activities of DLUC.
